6th Annual Apple Pie Contest

Sunday-September 4, 2011-Kendall County Fair Grounds-Exhibit Hall

OFFICIAL RULES AND REGULATIONS:

1. Contest Is Open To All Residents Of Kendall County, Except For Professional Bakers.
2. Entrants Will Be Divided Into Two Age Divisions: Senior And Junior Age Divisions. Senior-Age 18 And Older And Junior -Under 18 Years Of Age.
3. Pie(s) Must Be Pre-Registered. (NON-REGISTERED PIE(s) WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED ON CONTEST DAY). A Completed Pre-Registration Form And A \$5.00 Non-Refundable Entry Fee Must Be Received On Or Before August 25,2011. Entrants Will Be Mailed An Acknowledgement Of Acceptance Of Their Entry(s) With An Assigned Entry Number Along With A 5"x8" Inch Index Card With A Pass For Entry Into The Fairgrounds On Contest Day Sunday-September 4,2011. (One Pass Per Entrant). It Is The Responsibility Of The Entrant To Verify If The Committee Has Received The Entrants Pre-Registration Form And Entry Fee By August 25,2011.
4. Pie(s) Will Be Categorized Into Two Categories: Traditional Double Crust Or Single Crust With Non-Crusted Topping. Pie(s) Must Be Freshly Baked In A 9-Inch Disposable Baking Tin. Pie(s) Filling Must Be 60% Apples Made From Any Variety Of Fresh Or Frozen Apples, However The Filling May Include Other Fruits Or Ingredients, Pie(s) Crust Double Or Single Must Be Home Made From Scratch. No Store Bought Canned Pie Filling Or Store Bought Pie Shells Or Rolled Crust.
5. Pie(s) Recipe(s) Must Be Typed Or Legibly Hand Written Or Printed On A 5"x8" Index Card. All Ingredients Must Be Listed And Entrants Name Must Not Be Listed.
6. Pie(s) And Recipe(s) Must Be Checked In On Sunday-September 4,2011 From 8:00 A.M. Till 11:00 P.M. Judging Begins At 1:00 P.M. And Is Open To The Public.
7. The Kendall County Fair Association Will Select A Panel Of Experienced Bakers And/Or Chefs From The Local Food Industry For Judges. Judges Will Use A Scoring Scale Point System Of 1-5 (With 5 Being The Highest Point) To Assess Entries With A Perfect Score Of 100. Scoring Will Be The Sole Responsibility Of The Judges And The Judges Results Will Be Final. Judges Sheets Will Be Available To Entrants Upon Request After Contest.
8. Pie(s) Will Be Judged Before Initial Slicing On Overall Appearance For 15 Points And 10 Points For Creativity. After Slicing Pie(s) Will Be Judged On Crust For 20 Points, 25 Points For Filling And 30 Points For Flavor.
9. Awards In Each Age Division And Category Will Be Awarded For Best Appearance And Most Creative In Pre-Slicing And Best Crust, Best Taste And Overall Pie After Slicing. The Two Pies Awarded The Best Overall Pie From Each Age Division And Category Will Be Judged For The Award Placements Of Grand Prize, First Place, Second Place And Third Place. All Entrants Not Placing Will Receive A Participation Ribbon.
10. Grand Prize-\$50.00,First Place-\$35.00,Second Place-\$25.00 And Third Place-\$15.00 Plus Rosette Ribbons And A Plaque.
