Dear Scholarship Applicant:

In an effort to recognize outstanding quality youth of Kendall County, the Kendall County Fair Association, Inc. has established the Homestead Heritage Exhibit Hall Scholarship Program. Any high school senior who is a candidate for graduation in the year 2012 is eligible and is encouraged to apply for the scholarship.

The objective and purpose of the Homestead Heritage Exhibit Hall Scholarship program is to financially assist high school graduating seniors who are continuing their education of study in any field of agriculture, horticultural, floriculture, photography/art, taxidermy and/or any field of life skills of home arts related to crafting and baking/cooking.

The Homestead Heritage Exhibit Hall Scholarship program is funded by donations or sponsorship and/or proceeds of raffles and other fundraising opportunities held and sponsored during the fiscal year by the Kendall County Fair Association. The amounts of the scholarships are based on net yearly proceeds of funding opportunities. Scholarship Funds can be downloaded on applicants chosen college or university card to fund payment of tuition, enrollment fees, books, supplies and/or equipment required for courses of instruction at an accredited four-year college, university, junior college or TEA-approved trade school that offers an associate degree. Scholarship can be used for the fall, spring and/or summer semester during the year immediately following the individual's selection as the scholarship recipient. If the scholarship winner does not utilize available scholarship funds within one year the scholarship is forfeited and the scholarship funds will be retained by the Kendall County Fair Association, Inc. for future scholarship use. The scholarship is available to a high school senior who will graduate in 2012. The applicant must be citizen of the U.S. a resident of Kendall County and never been convicted of a criminal offense.

The scholarship application will be reviewed and judged by the Homestead Heritage Exhibit Hall Scholarship Committee of which may include an organization or individuals (outside of Kendall County) to select the scholarship recipient. Selection of the recipient will not be based on sex, race, religion, financial need, and/or class rank or scholastic major.

Each applicant will be evaluated on the basis of his or her application and references in academics, activities and leadership, essay, references and exceptional consideration. Each area is worth a total of 20 points. The highest possible score is 100 points. The highest rated student will receive the Homestead Heritage Exhibit Hall Scholarship. Parent/Guardian(s) lifetime membership of the Kendall County Fair Association, Inc. is not required but applicants parent/guardian(s) who are members of the association will be given preference. Scholarship recipient will be granted a lifetime membership into the Kendall County Fair Association, Inc. when he/she becomes eighteen years of age. Applicant's participation during the annual fair as an exhibitor and/or volunteer in the Homestead Heritage Exhibit Hall is not required but a strong preference will be given to those who have exhibited and/or volunteered time during the annual fair. All scholarship applications will become the property of the Kendall County Fair Association Homestead Heritage Exhibit Hall Scholarship Committee.

The deadline for scholarship applications will be April 1,2012. Any application that is mailed must be postmarked no later than April 1,2012. The Homestead Heritage Exhibit Hall Scholarship application is available on line at www.kcfa.org or from your high school counselor. Applicant's Counselor will be notified of winner on or before April 30,2012 and scholarship winner will be announced and presented at applicant's respective school's award program at the end of the 2012 school term.
