5. Classes will be broken by weight. Must be 8 head or more to split light and heavy.
6. No Boar Pigs.
7. There will be a 10# weigh back.
8. Must furnish own wood shavings.
9. Water only as a grooming material.
10. Classes: Duroc, Hamp, Yorks, OPB Light, OPB Dark, and Crosses.
11. Purebred Gilts may show in the Breeding class if additional \$5.00 entry fee is paid.

Showtime: Sunday, September 4, 2011, Following Breeding Cattle.

1. Exhibitors and Showmen must be Texas 4-H or FFA members, currently enrolled in Public or Private School below the college level.
2. There will be weight divisions: A minimum of 5 head to make a BREED class. If there are not 5 head per breed they will be put in appropriate classes of British, American, or European.
3. Steer must be sufficiently halter broke to be handled safely.
4. No adhesive except for on tailheads.
5. Stalling space is limited. There will be NO PREASSIGNED STALLS. Stalling will be on a first to arrive basis. When barn is full you will have to tie to your trailers. **No refund of fees.**
6. All cattle must meet current Texas Animal Health Commission Regulations.
